

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
FOR
THE HALLER AWARD
FOR THE CREATIVE USE OF STRUCTURAL MASONRY

ELIGIBILITY

The Haller Award is presented by The Masonry Society at North American Masonry Conferences to an individual engineer or an engineering firm that designed a work of structural masonry engineering completed since December 1, 1999 anywhere in the world. This structure must have unit masonry as the dominant structural building material. Structures could include a building, civil work, structure, or a portion thereof, including, but not limited to, arches, vaults, beams, bridges, chimneys, columns, fences, floors, foundations, girders, pavements, roofs, shells, and signs.

The structure must have been designed by a person licensed to practice the profession of engineering at the time the project was completed.

Nominations may be made by any person over 21 years of age on the form provided by The Masonry Society (TMS), or a photocopy of same.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Nominations will be judged on the basis of creative application of the principles of aesthetics, engineering, and economics to the design and construction of a masonry structural system.

HOW TO NOMINATE

All nomination forms must be completed according to the instructions or they will not be considered by the jury. Nomination forms, along with the nomination fee of \$50.00 for each nomination, must be received by TMS postmarked no later than December 1, 2006.

All materials for nominations must be contained in an 8.5 by 11 inch (220 by 280 mm) binder that will be supplied to each nominator upon receipt of the nomination form and fee. Completed nomination binders must be returned to TMS postmarked not later than February 1, 2007. All nominations will be reviewed for possible publication by TMS and others. Questions regarding the Haller Award will be answered by calling TMS at 303-939-9700.

Nominations that do not receive the Haller Award or that are not being considered for publication will be returned to the nominator. TMS cannot be held responsible for any material in the event of loss or damage.

NOMINATION MATERIALS

For each nomination made, the nominator must provide sufficient photographs, slides, plans, and specifications to illustrate the design. Nomination materials may not exceed the capacity of the nomination binder provided by TMS. The names of all engineers and firms and all project identification must be removed from submitted materials. However, evidence of engineering registration for the engineer of record must be provided upon request.

PHOTOGRAPHS

Photos should be 8 x 10 inch (200 x 250 mm) color prints or 3.0 megapixel (or better) digital pictures (on standard 5 inch (127 mm)

compact disks) in at least the following quantities:

- Two showing elevations
- Two close ups of the masonry details
- One showing the overall structure
- For a group of structures, one showing the overall project including surroundings
- For renovation or retrofit projects, one of each exposed side before and after
- Also include eight to ten 35 mm color slides or 3.0 megapixel (or better) digital pictures (on standard 5 inch (127 mm) compact disks), including elevations, interiors, and close ups of masonry details

DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Drawings should be provided at an appropriate scale showing all plans, elevations, sections, and details of the structural masonry. A hard copy of full or half sized construction document sheets or pdf files (on standard 5 inch (127 mm) compact disks) relevant to the masonry design must be submitted. Alternately, drawings must be on 8.5 x 11 inch (220 x 280 mm) sheets may be provided. A copy of the masonry section of the project specifications must also be provided.
